Policy Statement


The Marcliffe Hotel is committed to the following policy, that may help reduce working days lost due to illness and stop or slow the spread of COVID-19.

Our business is committed to the following:

- We shall promote awareness of the most current Government guidelines and follow best practice to avoid or slow the spread of Covid-19.
- We shall enforce social distancing whenever possible and provide suitable equipment such as face masks and gloves when social distancing is not possible.
- We shall ensure a high level of hygiene in our hotel and restaurant to reduce the risk of contamination with Covid-19.
- We shall record and protect customer contact details as required to assist with Covid-19 “test and protect”.
- We shall provide and promote the use of additional hand sanitizer stations.
- We shall avoid non-essential work meetings, site visits and social gatherings and make use of video / teleconferencing technology where possible.
- We shall encourage suppliers and contractors to adopt responsible Covid-19 policies and practices.
- All effort will be made to avoid stigma and discrimination at The Marcliffe Hotel. This could include personnel who have recently travelled to an area reporting Covid-19 cases, or other personnel who have conditions that put them at higher risk of serious illness (e.g. diabetes, heart and lung disease, older age).
- The Marcliffe Hotel will consider the mental health and social consequences of a case of COVID-19 in the workplace or in the community and offer information and support.
- We shall provide, and strive to maintain, a clean, healthy, and safe working environment in line with our HSE safe systems of work.

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis or when there is any significant change in practices.
